- Maintain and enforce high expectations, with particular respect to behaviour, in line with school policies, treating all students fairly and consistently
- Seek to provide an extensive programme of extra-curricular activities
- Provide support, ideas and access to expertise for families where appropriate

- Ensure their child attends school regularly (target 95%+) and on time, providing a note if absent
- Ensure their child is appropriately dressed for learning, in accordance with the uniform policy

- Provide a calm, orderly space to enable their child to complete all homework
- Attend school meetings as required
- Support all school policies, particularly with respect to behaviour for learning

- Engage in all learning tasks, asking for help or clarification when required
- Set themselves high standards and try their best at all times
- Use the planner to help organise themselves

- Complete all homework on time and to the best of their ability
- Join us in taking a stand against bullying
- Wear their uniform with pride
